Our members identified the seaweed farm licensing process as a key barrier to the growth of the EU seaweed industry



Seaweed licensing procedures are not always clearly defined:

- Applicants don't have the full picture when starting their journey
- Information is fragmented
- Process steps are often unclear
- Timings are often badly assessed



Future seaweed farmers are struggling to obtain seaweed farming licenses and get discouraged

Creation of a knowledge hub to help future farmers navigate the seaweed licensing procedure


